

2024 Sec 1 Registration MTL FAQ



Can my child do HCL/HML?

- Yes. If your child is given an e-option letter (form) by MOE during the collection of the PSLE result slips stating that they are eligible to read HCL/HML.
- No. If he/she is not given this e-option form, it means that the child is not eligible.



If the child is not given the option form and is still interested to read HCL, they can apply in accordance to Hua Yi MTL policy for HCL:

- In Hua Yi Secondary School, there will be 2 chances given for application to do HCL if the following criteria are met.
 - ✓ Sec 1 Summative review and overall CL results :75% & above
 - ✓ Sec 2 Summative review and overall CL results :75% & above
- Results of the core subjects will be taken into consideration.
- Coupled with strong recommendation by subject teachers.



Does the school offer HML (Higher Malay Language)?

- Hua Yi Secondary School does not offer HML.
- For students taking HML, they attend the lessons at Bukit Panjang High School once a week from 3p.m to 6p.m.



Does the school offer TL or HTL?

- Hua Yi Secondary School does not offer Tamil. For students doing TL, they do the subject at Jurongville Secondary School from 3 p.m to 6 p.m.
- For students offer HTL, they can do the subject at Jurong West Secondary School or Umar Pulava TL Centre.



Does the school offer CLB?

- Hua Yi Secondary School does not offer CLB.
- Students taking CLB have their lessons at Dunearn Secondary School which is the West Zone CLB Centre once a week from 2:45p.m to 5:30 p.m.



Can my child read a third language?

- For third language, MOE will inform eligible students concerned directly.
- Students will be given an e-option form and indicate their interest in taking up a third language.



For Students Exempted from MTL, doing MTL in-lieu or NTIL.

- If students are exempted from MTL, doing other languages for Mother Tongue in-lieu (such as Burmese, French and Thai languages) and Non Tamil Indian Languages (such as Bengali, Hindi and Punjabi), the following documents are required:

Approval letter from MOE which they have received in primary school.



For Students Exempted from MTL, doing MTL in-lieu or NTIL.

- If students cannot produce the verification documents, Sec 1 FTs will refer them to HOD/MTL for applications. The applications forms will be endorsed by parents with relevant documents attached. The form need to be returned to HOD/MTL for compilation and to be followed up with school leaders when 2024 starts.
- Approval is subjected to case by case consideration by MOE.
